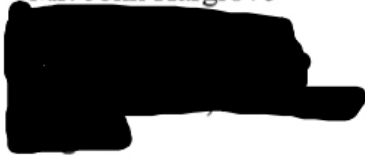


Mr. John Hargrove



**“[a]ny information, . . . disclosed to me or known to me (1) through or in the course of my employment with the Company, (2) not generally known outside the Company, and (3) relating to the actual or anticipated business of the Company. . .”**

A June 4, 2014 article in the online publication The Wrap (<http://www.thewrap.com/blackfish-star-john-hargrove-inks-book-deal-with-macmillan-publishing/>) states that the Book will “chronicle the former SeaWorld trainer’s 14 years in the water with killer whales,” including “extraordinary stories of the whales [you] worked with and came to love, [and your] “experiences in and out of the water.” The article also quotes you as stating that “there’s so many incidents that we did not bring up” in the film *Blackfish*, implying that the Book will include such purported incidents. It therefore appears that the Book may contain SeaWorld’s Confidential Information: information disclosed to you or known to you only through your employment with SeaWorld, which information is generally not known outside of SeaWorld and is related to SeaWorld’s business.

For the avoidance of doubt, SeaWorld does not consent to your use of Confidential Information in the Book.

Pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Hargrove Agreement, SeaWorld hereby requests that you immediately certify, in writing and under oath, that during your employment with SeaWorld and subsequent to your separation from SeaWorld, you have not disclosed or used in any way Confidential Information, including in connection with the Book. For your convenience, I have attached a form of certification for your use.

If you are able to truthfully make the requested certification under oath, please do so and return the form to me within ten (10) days of this letter. I assume if we do not hear from you within ten (10) days, you are unable or unwilling to submit such certification to SeaWorld.

Should you fail to make this certification as requested, SeaWorld reserves its right to exercise all of its rights and remedies against you (and Macmillan Publishing) at law and in equity, all of which are hereby expressly reserved.
