64 y/o male found on LSB, on scene with NOFD. Pt c/o neck pain. Per witness, pt was assaulted, fell to the ground, and had positive LOC. Positive ETOH. Pt denies the ability to feel his extremities. Upon assessment, pt alert and oriented x4, ABCs intact, positive pulses and negative for mobility or sensation to extremities. Pt poked several times with no response. HEENT unremarkable, clear, bilateral breath sounds with equal chest expansion, abdomen soft, non tender to palpation, vis as above. Pt denies chest pain or shortness of breath. Pt poked up, placed on stretcher, and secured with straps. Pt monitored on route to University Medical Center without further change. Pt care to staff. Pt left in room 2643 as a trauma activation.
