**APPELLEE’S JOINDER IN
APPELLANT’S MOTION FOR
A ONE-WEEK EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE
SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFS**

The United States of America respectfully joins Appellant Duncan D. Hunter’s motion for a one-week extension of time so that both parties may file their supplemental briefs simultaneously as originally contemplated by this Court.

On September 25, 2019, this Court issued an order providing, in pertinent part, that “the parties may file simultaneous supplemental briefs not to exceed 20 pages within 14 days . . .” Docket Entry (“Dkt”) 12. On September 30, 2019, Hunter requested “a one-week extension, such that both parties may file simultaneous supplemental briefs not to exceed 20 pages . . .” Dkt. 14. The United States did not oppose the request for a one-week extension of the filing date, as long as it would not impact this Court’s ability to hear argument in December 2019 and issue a ruling in advance of the scheduled January 2020 trial date.

For the reasons set forth in the attached declaration of counsel, the United States requests that it be accorded the same one-week extension so that both parties may file their briefs simultaneously as originally indicated by the Court.
