Re: Unlawful Purple Tier School Reopenings in San Diego County

I write on behalf of the San Dieguito Faculty Association (SDFA). SDFA hereby requests that the San Dieguito Unified High School District immediately cease and desist in the implementation of its current plan to return to in-person hybrid instruction at its secondary schools and high schools in January 2021. It is not only the wrong step at the wrong time in this dangerous phase in the pandemic, but also prohibited by governing state law. Please see the attached courtesy copy of a letter to the San Diego County Office of Education, correcting prior inaccurate advice the office has provided to your district, and outlining why the district's current reopening plans are unlawful under state law. Please provide us with written confirmation, not later than the close of business December 15, 2020, that SDUHSD will take the necessary steps to comply with CDPH reopening rules.
